



December's Town Hall

- We are experiencing a "syndemic" (synergistic epidemic).
 - We are seeing increased overdose deaths due to pandemiccaused system changes.
 - We are seeing increased risk of severe COVID-related outcomes to people with recent SUD.
- Vaccine prioritization may lead to debates, challenges, and frustrations at the local level for the next few months.
- Many barriers and challenges remain to ensure successful vaccination campaigns, especially for people who use drugs, who are a highly vulnerable group.





